Shepherds — this group participates with the children and guides them from place to place throughout the morning for the different activities; no planning or teaching required. You need an enthusiastic spirit and a love for kids. VBS time commitment is from 8:30am – 12:30pm every day the week of VBS and to attend the training. Day Camp time commitment is from 8:30am – 3:45pm Monday—Thursday and 8:30am—12:30pm Friday the week of VBS and to attend the training.

Assistants — work with the Shepherds to guide the participants from place to place and assists the adults in all activities; no planning or teaching required. You need an enthusiastic spirit and a love for kids. VBS time commitment is from 8:30am – 12:30pm every day the week of VBS and to attend the training. Day Camp time commitment is from 8:30am – 3:45pm Monday—Thursday and 8:30am—12:30pm Friday the week of VBS and to attend the training.

Arts & Crafts Assistant — will assist the Arts & Crafts Leader with all activities. Time commitment is from 8:30am – 12:30pm every day the week of VBS and to attend the training.

Science Assistant — will assist the Science Leader with all activities. Time commitment is from 8:30am – 12:30pm every day the week of VBS and to attend the training.

Games Leader — will lead the kids in active and creative games that explore the Bible stories, emphasize teamwork and fair play. There are a variety of resources that contain a wide variety of interactive games from which to choose. Time commitment is from 8:30am – 12:30pm every day the week of VBS and to attend the training.
